Workplaces are changing. It is estimated that, in 20 years' time, 90% of all jobs will require people to work with digital technologies. Already, 72% of large firms struggle to recruit workers with digital skills.

Find out about digital capabilities in your organisation

Sitting at the heart of the service is the digital capability discovery tool, an empowering first step for staff and students to reflect on their digital capabilities through a series of questions. It helps them identify current strengths and areas for development. On completion, staff and students receive a personalised report with suggested next steps and links to free resources that can help them develop further. You can also add your own training resources.

It is the only tool of its kind available for the education sector. We also have guides and case studies to help you develop digital capability across your organisation.
